

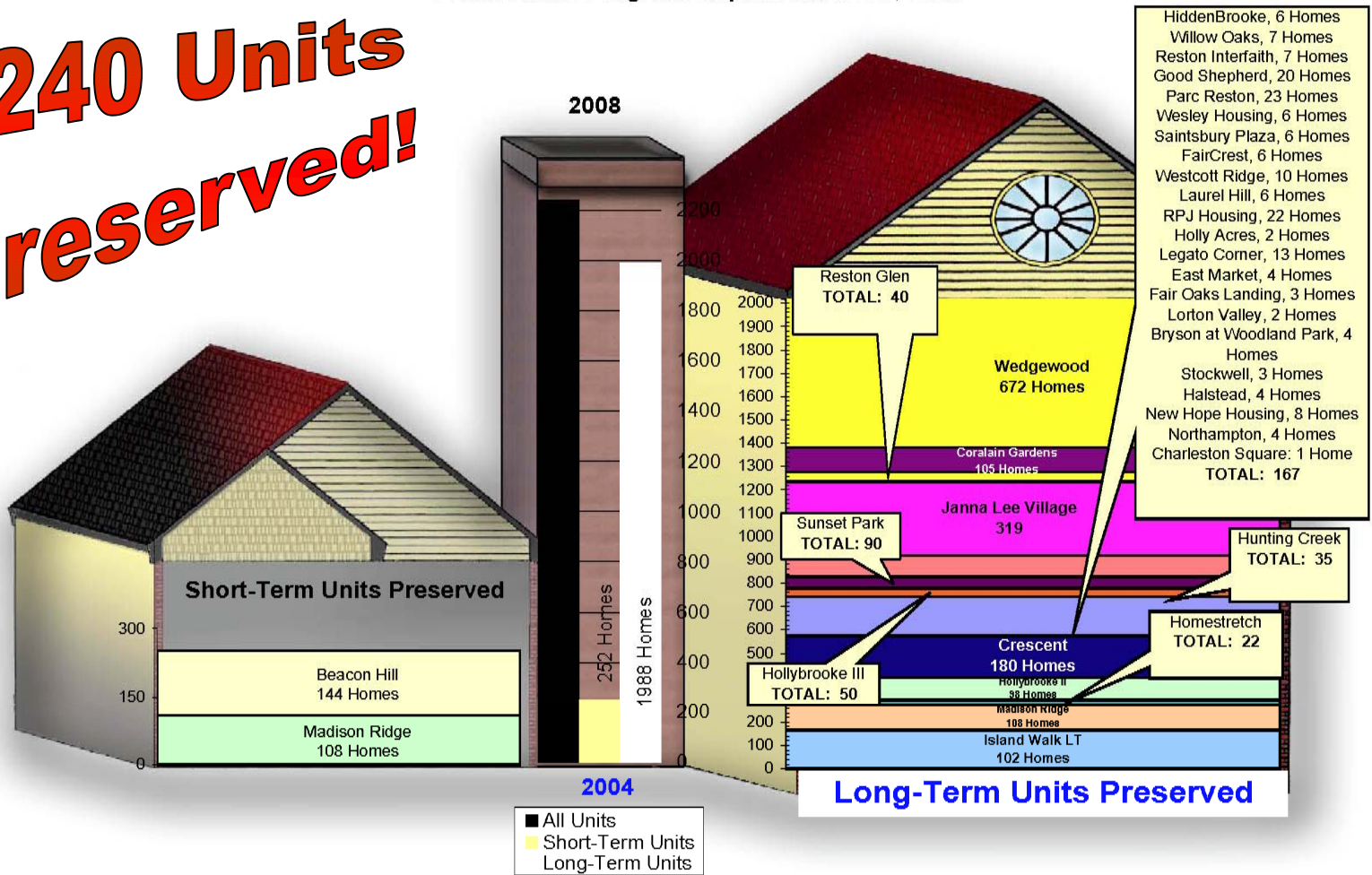

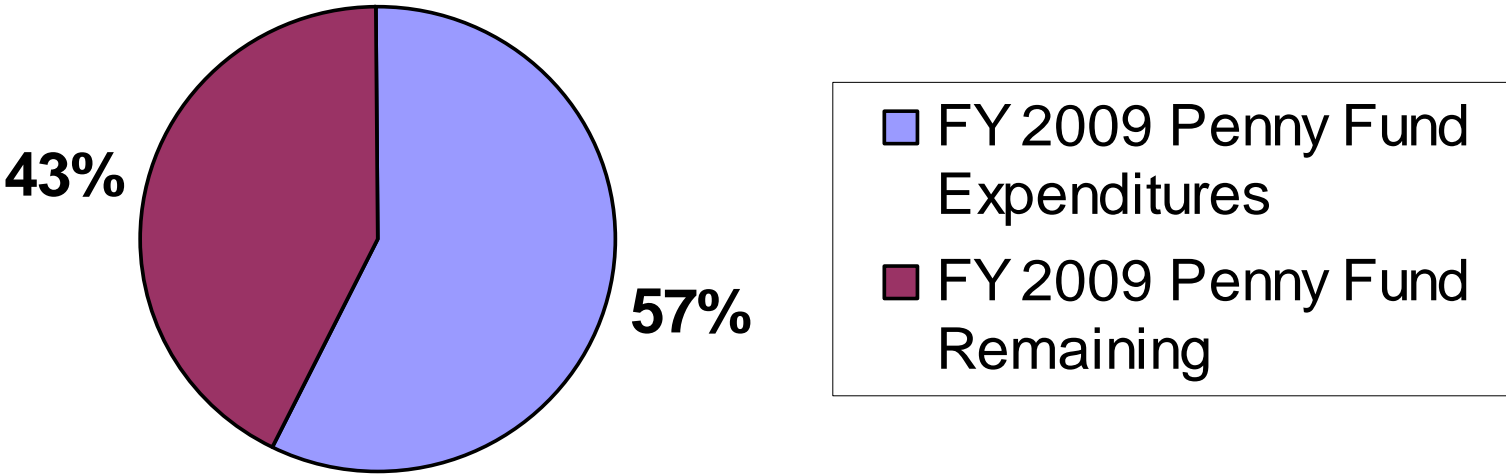

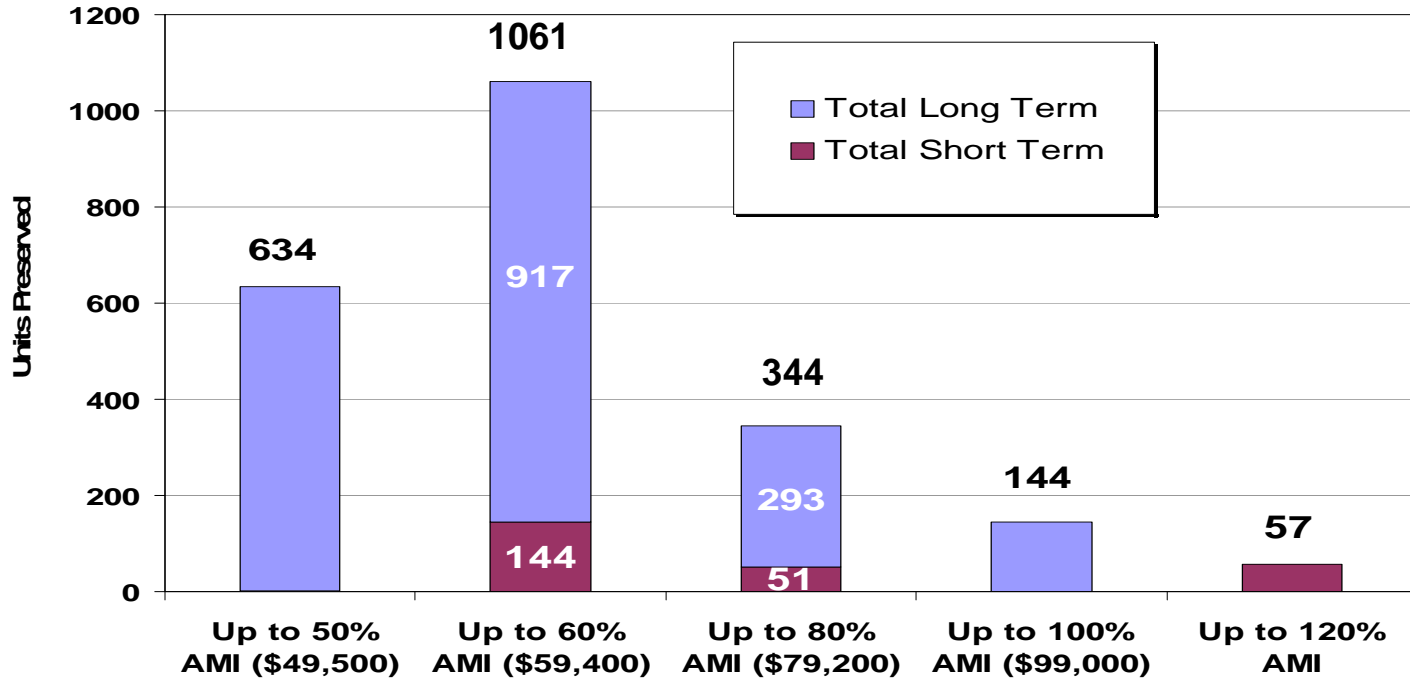

Penny for Affordable Housing Expenditures, Obligations and Commitments FY 2009

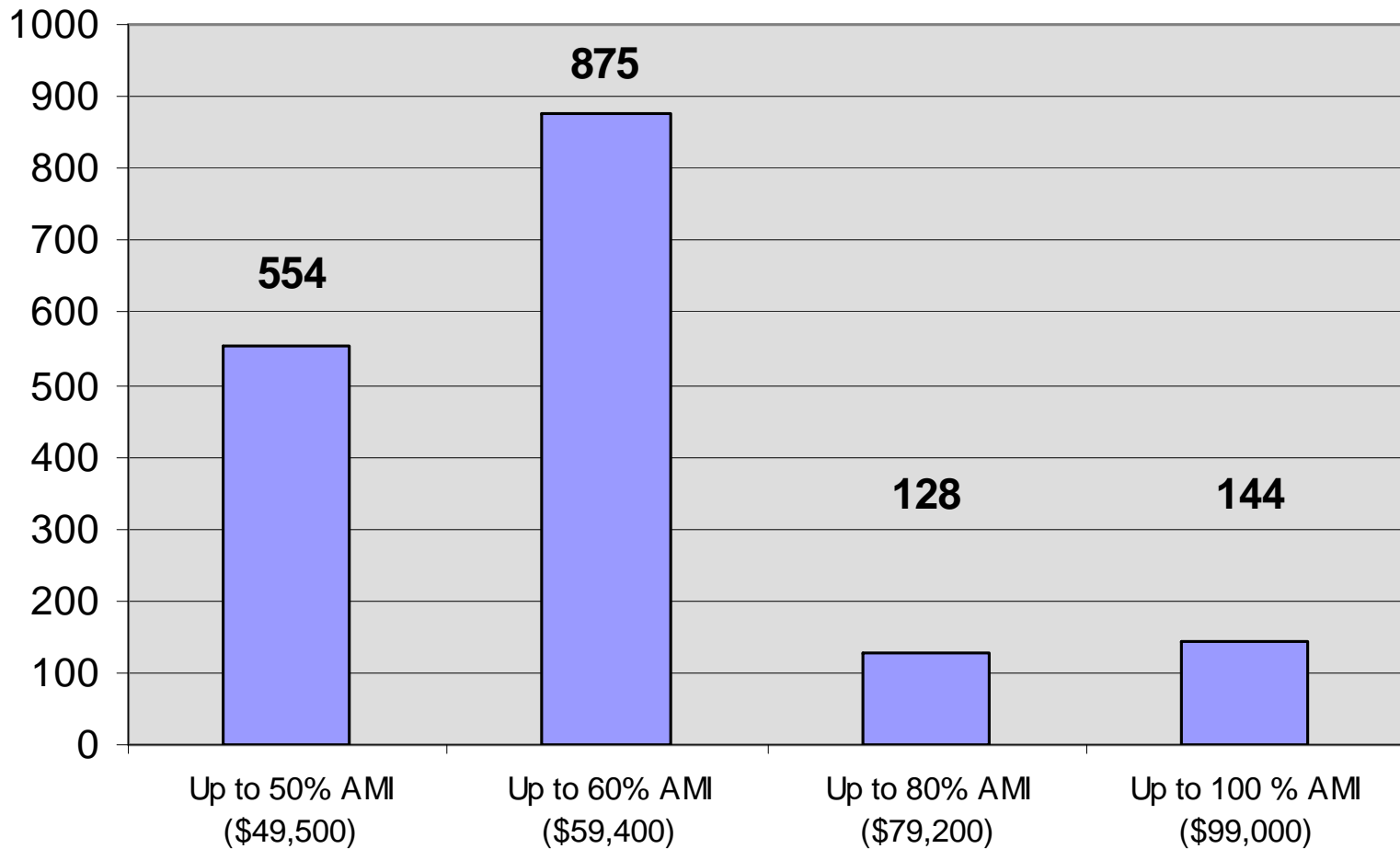


Affordability of Units Preserved; All Funding Sources: April 2004 to Present
